Step-by-Step Directions for Organizers

This guide walks you through the process of organizing your virtual choir in four easy steps:

01 Share Guide Files in Dropbox

Consider doing two versions one entirely in English and another version where you translate the 1st Chorus into your first language.

02 Set a Deadline to record

for your choir to learn their parts

03 Rehearse

04 Record

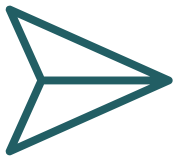

Send guide files to your students



The song is a catchy rap song!! Divid the verses into three groups ie: Sopranos sing the first verse, Altos the second verse, and Tenors the 3rd verse. This will make it very easy for each young person to remember their particular verse. Then as per the guide tracks everyone sings on the choruses.

Setting a deadline for everyone to know their parts will ensure a wonderful first rehearsal goes smoothly!

This is not your typical choral song. Having Soprano, Alto and Tenor voices singing their own verse creates a novel approach.



3 Rehearse

Rehearse....it will be fun for your students to hear how this comes together with ease given that everyone is responsible for their own verse and then everyone is in on the chorus. Feel free to coordinate some choreography with your students.

Record 4

Please see our attached guide for recording. We suggest you use a separate recording device (even iPhones and Samsung record great audio these days). The song is at 99BPM ensure that you create consistent momentum by either having the backing track at low volume behind your choir and also record a version where you don't use the backing track. We have sent you a solo drum loop to work with too.

Film your youth choir and upload the files as per the link in this document to YOUTH4PLANET

PS we suggest you record two versions: one entirely in English and one version where you translate the first Chorus into your first language.

1. Record vision
2. Record sound
3. Option to record in your language the first chorus
4. If you have the talent, to record 3 solo artists on SAT
