Artist/ Composer, Musical Director, and Producer Corinne Gibbons

Corinne is an award-winning artist who has collaborated with Phil Collins and great instrumentalists who have supported, Michael Jackson, Ray Charles, Bette Midler, Phil Collins Justin Timberlake.

Her first shows as a young artist were with Australian Jazz legends Don Burrows and George Golla. By the age of 24 Corinne had toured with Jack Sonni from "Dire Straits" sung with The Count Basie Big Band and recorded with Tower Of Power.

Corinne's trailblazing album of healing, Melt was made in collaboration with National Geographic. As a multi-media show, Melt has won multiple awards including a World Peace Award (UK) and two World & Nature film awards (USA) and was performed to audiences as large as 10,000 people in multiple countries.

A champion for environmental awareness from a young age, Corinne recently partnered with Sisters Grimm to co-create" Life" as part of ART in Nature Global program for children.

Corinne is a thought leader in Children's creative education. Her Search for the Sparkle program has engaged thousands of children to find their voice and keep song writing journals of their childhoods. She is now collaborating with John Tafone in NYC to bring Search for The Sparkle to the stage. Sparkle embraces a story of multi- cultural, multi-lingual song writing and a story that weaves cultural nuance and honouring of first nations wisdom globally.

Corinne is passionate about co-creating inclusive platforms for all youth voices and believes that music plays a key role in creating social change.
